- **New CD ROM on the Relationship of Adverse Childhood Experiences to Adult Health Status**

The *Adverse Childhood Experiences Study (ACE Study)* is the product of collaboration between Vincent J. Felitti, MD of Kaiser Permanente and Robert F. Anda, MD of the National Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This groundbreaking research examines the relationship between current adult health status and adverse childhood experiences. Results demonstrate a clear link between childhood exposure to abuse and multiple risk factors for several of the leading causes of death and illness in adults. Information and findings of the ACE study are now available on DVD/CD. The DVD/CD features a presentation delivered by Dr. Vincent Felitti in September 2003 on the ACE study findings and the implications for health policy and practice presentation. The DVD/CD includes in-depth information about Dr. Felitti's research as well as video clips of patients exposed to adverse childhood experiences talking about the impact of those experiences on their health.
