### **University of New Hampshire Family Research Laboratory Program, Post-Doctoral Fellowships for Research on Family Violence**

Postdoctoral fellowships are available for research on family violence. Positions are open to new and experienced researchers with doctorates in the fields of psychology, sociology, social work, law, nursing, public health and medicine. The fellowships are intended for work in the area of child abuse, marital violence, elder abuse, sexual abuse, child victimization, rape, homicide and other family-violence related topics with special attention to mental health impact. Scholars use the one-year fellowships (with possible one-year extension) to collaborate with Family Research Laboratory (FRL) faculty on a current project, to work on one of the many data sets archived at the FRL or, in the case of senior candidates, to work on their own projects.
